

PROMOTING APPROACHES THAT FAVOUR A CIRCULAR ECONOMY AND GOOD WASTE MANAGEMENT AMONGST THE MEDITERRANEAN ISLANDS WITHIN THE SMILO COMMUNITY

8-10 NOVEMBER 2022























# CONTEXT

The Mediterranean Sea is one of the most affected seas by marine litter, especially plastics. This problem has huge impacts on island communities and biodiversity. The islands are home to remarkable habitats and species sensitive to litter. The growing consumption of single-use plastics, the inappropriate management of waste generated by seasonal tourism, or even dumped waste also impact the key economic sectors of the Mediterranean islands, in particular fishing and tourism.

The Mediterranean benefits from numerous waste assessment and management initiatives. In broader terms, islands and Marine Protected Areas are working increasingly more towards sustainable development, sharing their best practices and joining forces. However, projects and interventions are often scattered, resulting in small-scale impact, absence of harmonised approaches in terms of monitoring and mitigation, insufficient replicability of successful measures, low uptake by local managers of tools to effectively tackle waste, and low impact on regional policy processes, among others. The results and products of these projects are often only available at the local level, fragmented and spatially limited to the northern part of the basin, so that it is impossible to draw basin-wide conclusions.

# **OBJECTIVES OF THE EVENT**

The objectives of the event are:

- To have an impact on waste reduction by capitalising on the collaborative achievements of Mediterranean island projects in favour of circular economy, sustainable waste management and the prevention of plastics in:
- 1. Promoting collaboration between island projects.
- 2.Transferring approaches, results and lessons learned from individual projects to other islands to build capacity, as well as to support the creation of new island partnerships.
- 3.Integrate projects and program results at different scales: from the local level (with Frioul whose territorial planning strategy & SMILO certification process will be at the heart of the exchanges) to the regional level (European programs, Barcelona Convention, BeMed).
- To promote the good practices of Frioul and the participating islands. To create exchanges between the islands within the SMILO network and beyond, in connection with the management and prevention of waste, but also more generally on the sustainable management of the islands. This meeting aims to encourage the emergence of new partnerships between the islands and exchanges of good practices on the key issues of each island.
