This edition, WeMed Award is targeting **Business Support Organizations (BSOs) and Entrepreneurs/Start-ups** that are or have been direct **beneficiaries of at least one of the 19 EU-Projects* analysed under RESET** in the field of Green Business Creation & Circular Economy. Applicants should have benefited from one of the Outputs (Best Practices, Knowledge, Tool) in one of the Mediterranean eligible regions within the ENI CBC MED Program and have women and/or youth in their team.

This year's WeMed Awards will feature the following categories and prizes:

Category 1: **Business Support Organisations** (2 Awards)

- 1 Northern Med Award: Prize of 9,000€
- 1 Southern Med Award: Prize of 9,000€

Category 2: **Entrepreneurs/Start-ups** (4 Awards)

- 2 Northern Med Awards: Prize of 9,000€ per Award (Total: 18,000€)
